

<sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.




## PSALM 119:105 TPT

<sup>105</sup> Truth's shining light guides me in my choices and decisions; the revelation of your word makes my pathway clear.


## PROVERBS 13:12 NIV


## JEREMIAH 29:10-11 NLT
