Psalm 6:6

I am worn out from my *groaning*.
All night long I flood my bed with *weeping*
and drench my couch with *tears*.

John 11:35

Jesus *wept.*

Mark 15:34

At three o'clock, Jesus groaned out of the depths, crying loudly, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which means, "My God, my God, why have you *abandoned* me?"

Matthew 28:5-6

Taking a good look at them, he said: “Go, show yourselves to the priests.”

Luke 17:11-19

They went, and while still on their way, became clean. One of them, when he realized that he was healed, turned around and came back, *shouting his gratitude, glorifying God. He kneeled at Jesus' feet, so grateful. He couldn't thank Him enough* – and he was a Samaritan.

Jesus said, “Were not ten healed? Where are the nine? Can none be found to come back and give glory to God except this outsider?” Then he said to him, “Get up. On your way. Your faith has *healed and saved* you.”
