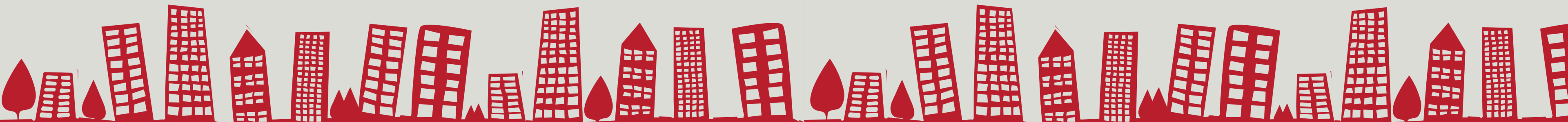

STEP 1

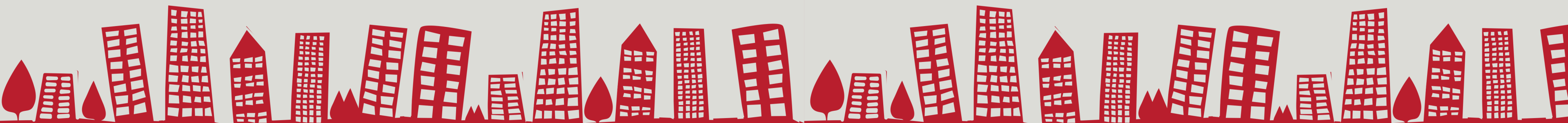
Complete our Intake Form on our website, this will help us look after your family in the best possible way. One of our Champions Club Team Members will get hold of you to discuss your answers.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE DAY

When you arrive you will walk up the small ramp at the back entrance of the school. This will allow for less distractions and quickest access to our Champions area.

At the top of the ramp you will meet your Champion leaders who will sign you in and have a name tag ready. Parents/ guardians will receive a corresponding number to be returned when the Champion is collected. Please note only the parent with the tag may fetch our Champions.

Parents/ guardians will take their champion to drop their belongings in their designated container.

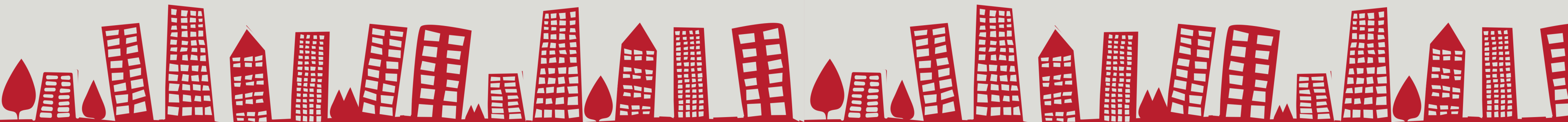
Our wonderful team will escort the champions to their first station.

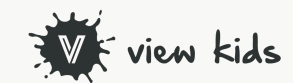

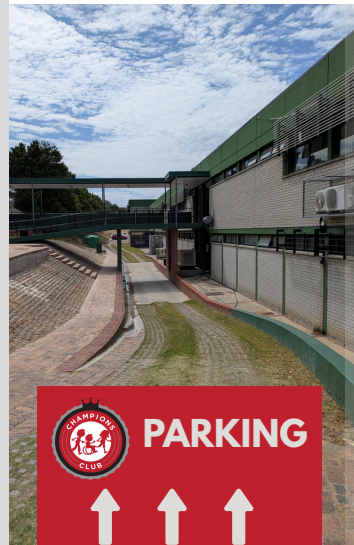

In this room your child will focus on physical activity and sensory learning to aide engagement and participation.



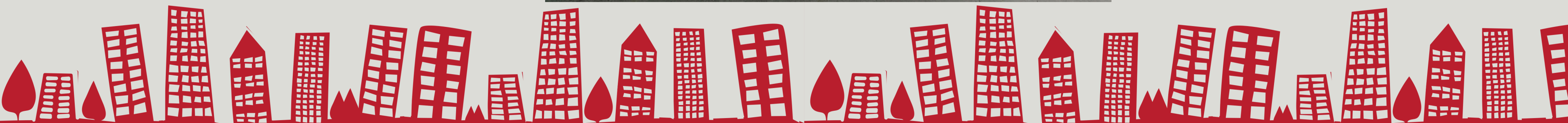
