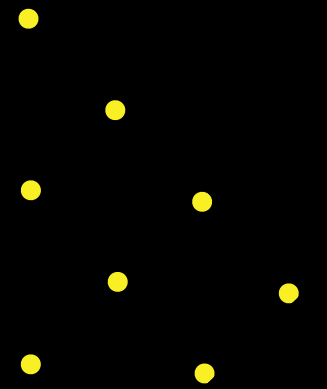

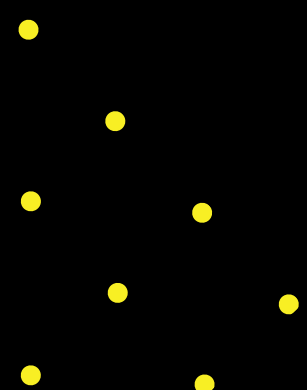

The gifts of the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 12:1-4



¹ Now about the gifts of the Spirit, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed. ² You know that when you were pagans, somehow or other you were influenced and led astray to mute idols. ³ Therefore I want you to know that no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, “Jesus be cursed,” and no one can say, “Jesus is Lord,” except by the Holy Spirit.



1 Corinthians 12:1-4



⁴ There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. ⁵ There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. ⁶ There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

⁷ Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. ⁸ To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit,

⁷ Now to each one the **manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.** ⁸ To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits,

to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines.



WORK OF THE *Spirit*





διαίρέσεις (Greek: diaireseis—varieties plural)

Paul uses this word three times in relation to gifts, service/ministries, and workings.



The criteria for knowing whether it is the Spirit at work or not is the proclamation that Jesus is Lord.

Revelation Gifts



These gifts **reveal** something that could not be known by natural means.

Word of Wisdom

God's supernatural wisdom for what to do.

| While a word of knowledge reveals **what is**,
a word of wisdom reveals **what should be done**



Matthew 22:15–22

When asked about paying taxes to Caesar, Jesus gave a wise answer that avoided the trap and revealed God's perspective.



Word of Wisdom



Purpose

A word of wisdom may:

- **Give direction.**
- **Solve difficult problems.**
- **Reveal God's strategy.**
- **Guide leaders.**
- **Bring peace and unity.**



Revelation Gifts



These gifts **reveal** something that could not be known by natural means.

Word of Knowledge

A word of knowledge is a supernatural revelation from the Holy Spirit about a fact, person, or situation that the speaker could not know through natural means.



John 4:16–19

Jesus revealed that the woman had had five husbands and was living with a man who was not her husband. This knowledge led her to recognize Him as a prophet.



Word of Knowledge



Purpose

A word of knowledge may:

- **Reveal hidden facts.**
- **Bring conviction.**
- **Confirm God's presence.**
- **Help people receive ministry.**
- **Protect the church from deception.**



Revelation Gifts



These gifts **reveal** something that could not be known by natural means.

Discerning of Spirits

God's insight into the spiritual source behind what is happening.



Discerning of Spirits



The Holy Spirit

Recognizing God's presence and activity.

Example: The church in Antioch recognized the Holy Spirit speaking to set apart Barnabas and Saul (Acts 13:2).

Demonic spirits

Identifying demonic influence or oppression.

Example: Paul discerned that the slave girl in Philippi was speaking by "a spirit of divination" and cast it out (Acts 16:16–18).

The human spirit

Recognizing when something is simply human rather than inspired by God or by evil.

Scripture teaches that not everything spiritual-sounding is from God (1 John 4:1).

Power Gifts



Power Gifts



These gifts demonstrate **God's power** in action.

Faith

The gift of faith is a supernatural confidence given by the Holy Spirit to believe God for what seems impossible, resulting in His power being displayed.





Acts 27:21–25

After receiving God's promise that everyone on board would survive, Paul declared:

"Keep up your courage, because I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me."

Gifts of Healings

Restores what is broken.



Power Gifts



These gifts demonstrate **God's power** in action.

Working of Miracles

Changes circumstances through God's supernatural intervention.



GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

Speaking Gifts



Utterance Gifts



These gifts involve speaking under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Prophecy

A message from God in a language everyone understands.



Utterance Gifts



These gifts involve speaking under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Tongues

A message from God in a language the speaker has not learned.



Utterance Gifts



These gifts involve speaking under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Interpretation of Tongues

Communicating the meaning of that message so the church is edified.



Mark 16:17



¹⁷ And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues



Acts 2:1-4

**...All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit
and began to speak in other tongues as the
Spirit enabled them.**



1 Corinthians 14:10-19



¹⁰ There are many different languages in the world, and every language has meaning. ¹¹ But if I don't understand a language, I will be a foreigner to someone who speaks it, and the one who speaks it will be a foreigner to me. ¹² And the same is true for you. Since you are so eager to have the special abilities the Spirit gives, seek those that will strengthen the whole church.



1 Corinthians 14:10-19



¹³ So anyone who speaks in tongues should pray also for the ability to interpret what has been said.

¹⁴ For if I pray in tongues, my spirit is praying, but I don't understand what I am saying. ¹⁵ Well then, what shall I do? I will pray in the spirit, and I will also pray in words I understand. I will sing in the spirit, and I will also sing in words I understand.

¹⁶ For if you praise God only in the spirit, how can those who don't understand you praise God along with you? How can they join you in giving thanks when they don't understand what you are saying?



1 Corinthians 14:10-19



¹⁷ You will be giving thanks very well, but it won't strengthen the people who hear you.

¹⁸ I thank God that I speak in tongues more than any of you. ¹⁹ But in a church meeting I would rather speak five understandable words to help others than ten thousand words in an unknown language.
